PURPOSE: The Schools for Advanced Studies is an option designed to support and expand Gifted/Talented Programs in local schools throughout the District. The Schools for Advanced Studies Program (SAS) Demonstration Sites were developed to provide high-level academic programs that serve the educational needs of gifted and high achieving learners. The program serves students in Grades K–12.

MAJOR CHANGES: This Reference Guide replaces the Student Integration Services REF-2404.6 of the same subject dated March 27, 2009. This Reference Guide provides the current student application, includes the current list of SAS schools, revises the student eligibility criteria and provides the notification dates.

INSTRUCTIONS: I. APPLICATION CALENDAR FOR THE SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES (SAS) PROGRAM

Qualified students currently enrolled in Grades pre-K–11 who live within LAUSD boundaries may apply for a transfer permit to attend one of the District’s Schools for Advanced Studies. Acceptance is based on student eligibility criteria and availability of space. Students accepted into the program do not receive transportation.

A. Enrollment

Enrollment application period begins May 3–May 31, 2010
 Notification of applicants June 1–11, 2010
 Deadline for receiving late SAS applications August 20, 2010
 SAS transfers may be extended throughout the school year, as space permits.

B. Selection

All applications must be date- and time-stamped when received. It is recommended that eligible applicants be selected by the date and time order the application is received or by a locally designed process (i.e., lottery) that supports existing SAS policy detailed in the Office of the Chief Academic Officer BUL-2508.2, *Transfer of Elementary and Secondary Students to Schools for Advanced Studies*, available online.

Admittance priority is as follows:

1. Qualifying students who live within school boundaries receive first priority.
2. Second priority goes to LAUSD qualifying students who live outside school boundaries.

Qualifying criterion is found on the reverse side of the application included in this Reference Guide as Attachment A.

C. School SAS Status

During the 2010-2011 school year, all current SAS schools will be required to reapply for the SAS designation for the 2011-2012 school year. Details will be forthcoming in the revised Office of the Chief Academic Officer BUL-3360.1, *Implementation and Maintenance of Schools for Advanced Studies Demonstration Sites*.

II. APPLICATION AND SCHOOLS FOR ADVANCED STUDIES LIST

The application must be completed and signed by the parent/guardian, signed by the principal or administrative designee of the school of attendance, and submitted to the SAS school of choice. (The application is enclosed as Attachment A.) Schools designated as Schools for Advanced Studies for the 2010–2011 school year at elementary and secondary levels are listed on Attachment B.

Sections I and II are in keeping with the District policies established in the Office of the Chief Academic Officer BUL-2508.2, *Transfer of Elementary and Secondary Students to Schools for Advanced Studies*, which is online.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application must be completed and signed by the parent/guardian, signed by the principal or administrative designee of the school of attendance, and submitted to the SAS school of choice. It is recommended that a brief interview and review of work samples for very young children be included to complete a student profile for appropriate educational placement. The teacher or administrator familiar with student’s eligibility must also sign the application (see below).

CRITERIA

SAS sites are open to applicants currently in Grades Pre-K–11 who reside within the LAUSD boundaries. Students who demonstrate superior academic achievement may apply. These applicants must meet one of the following:

1. Students currently on the magnet waiting list for gifted/high-ability or highly gifted magnet centers are eligible and may apply.
2. Students identified as gifted/talented in the intellectual, high achievement, or specific academic categories are eligible and may apply.
3. Students who have national percentile scores of 85 or above on standardized achievement tests in both total reading and total mathematics.
4. Students who have scaled scores on the California Standards Test (CST) as follows:
 - ___ A scaled score of 425 or above in English-Language Arts, grades 2–11 and
 - ___ A scaled score of 450 or above in mathematics, grades 2–7 or
 - ___ A scaled score of 450 or above for grades 8 and above in one of the following math content subjects: Algebra I or II; Geometry; Integrated Math I, II, or III; High School Summative Math
5. Students who demonstrate mastery of all four of the critical-thinking and problem-solving skills in their primary language:
 - ___ Explain meanings or relationships among facts, information or concepts that demonstrate depth and complexity.
 - ___ Formulate new ideas or solutions and elaborate on the information.
 - ___ Use alternative methods in approaching new or unfamiliar mathematical problems.
 - ___ Use extensive vocabulary easily and accurately to express creative ideas.

PROCESO DE APLICACION

REQUISITOS

 - ___ Una puntuación en la escala de 425 o más en Artes de Lenguaje, grados 2-11 y
 - ___ Una puntuación en la escala de 450 o más en Matemáticas, grados 2-7 o
 - ___ Una puntuación en la escala de 450 o más en materias matemáticas, grados 8 en adelante en uno de los cursos siguientes: Algebra I o II; Geometría; Matemáticas Integrada I, II, o III; Matemáticas Sumativa en la escuela superior
