State Level

One story from each grade level will be chosen as the state winner and awarded:

- Medal
- \$100 savings bond
- \$100 worth of resources for their teacher
- Expense-paid trip to Sacramento for student, teacher and two parents/ guardians for an awards ceremony during National Agriculture Week

- Submit the top five stories from your
- Each story must have an entry form attached
- Individual grade categories: grades 3-8
- Each story must be individually written by student authors
- Stories should not be similar in theme to winning entries from previous years' contests




Winning Stories must be:
